### ALERT!! Possible Scam Phone Calls to Parishioners. To All Locations:

**Message from the Diocese Finance Office:** We have been made aware of a telephone scam seeking to get donors to redirect their donations to a different bank account. The caller falsely represents themselves as a representative of the Diocese and the parish. The caller claims that the bank accounts have been changed and that the parishioner needs to redirect online payments to a new bank account.

Neither the Diocese nor any parish location would contact a donor asking them to change the bank account for their electronic donations. Be wary of all phone scams!

The Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph is committed to combatting sexual abuse in the Church. If you are a victim of sexual abuse, or if you observe or suspect sexual abuse:

1. Call the Missouri Child Abuse Hotline at 1.800.392.3738 (if the victim is currently under the age of 18), and
2. Contact your local law enforcement agency or call 911, and
3. After reporting to these civil and law enforcement authorities, report suspected sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult to the Ombudsman at 816-213-6024 or [ombudsman@ombudsmankcsj.org](mailto:ombudsman@ombudsmankcsj.org) if the abuse involves a priest, deacon, employee, or volunteer of the Diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph.

## Commandments for the Month of May-Week 2

**"You shall not covet your neighbor's wife."  
"You shall not covet your neighbor's goods."**

Covetousness is a condition of the heart that provokes words and actions that harm others and damage relationships. Healthy desires are made possible by God's desire for us to live fulfilling lives and to serve one another. Coveting is when our desires become disordered, focused on pleasing or promoting oneself at the detriment of others.

The symptoms of coveting include jealousy, lust, discontentment, being sad at the good fortunes of others or being happy about their bad fortunes. Being aware of these symptoms gives us the opportunity to examine why our feelings are disordered, and then take corrective steps to reorder our desires by replacing selfishness with gratitude, generosity, and genuine concern for others.
